With the start of the fall semester quickly approaching, we are excited to announce some of the events we have planned for the next few weeks.

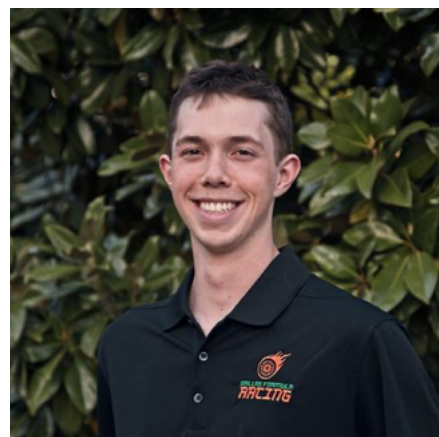
August 31st Kick Off Meeting Join us to learn more about Dallas Formula Racing, our plans for IC and EV, and how to join the team! More info
